Day Two SEATTLE, WASHINGTON

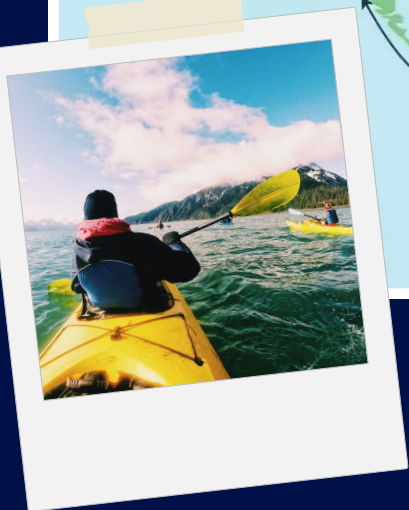

Day Five **SKAGWAY, ALASKA**

In a single year from 1896 to 1897, this remote town grew from a few tents to a city of 20,000 gold seekers. Today, travelers come in search of other riches, and experience Skagway's charming boardwalk lined with buildings that replicate those Gold Rush days.

Day Six **GLACIER BAY (CRUISING)**

Sail to Glacier Bay National Park, a United Nations World Heritage Site. Comprised of 3.3 million acres of national wonders, this is home to magnificent glaciers, snow-capped mountains, and an abundance of birds and wildlife.

Day Seven **KETCHIKAN, ALASKA**

Thanks to the immense amount of rainfall, Ketchikan is surrounded by some of the world's most lush wilderness. The Native American meaning of it's name is "spread wings of the eagle," so chances are you will see these magnificent birds during your visit here.

Day Eight **VICTORIA, BRITISH COLUMBIA**

Roam the spacious and stunning Butchart Gardens, with exotic flora and exquisite fountains. Explore the historic Bastion Square and treasures of Chinatown. Many sights to see here!
